A call for applications is now open for admission to Level 1 of the Master's program in the Advanced Program of Specialisation in Public Finance, for the 2026/2027 academic year, at the single centre in Yaoundé.

I. Face-to-face training

- Public Economics and Public Management: 25 places;
- Taxation, Finance and Public Accounting: 25 places;
- Territorial Governance and Local Public Finance: 25 places;
- Public Procurement and Public-Private Partnerships: 25 places;
- Audit and Control of Public Finance: 25 places.

II. Distance Training/E-Learning

- Public Economics and Public Management: 10 places;
- Taxation, Finance and Public Accounting: 10 places;
- Territorial Governance and Local Public Finance: 10 places;
- Public Procurement and Public-Private Partnerships: 10 places;
- Audit and Control of Public Finance: 10 places.

A.) Eligibility criteria

Applications are open to candidates of either gender with the following criteria:

1. Hold a university degree equivalent to a A/L +3 with a basic background in economics, management, law or a related discipline.
2. Have at least five (05) years' experience in a department or organisation directly linked to public finance.

NB: Recognition of prior learning and experience may take precedence, depending on the consistency between the candidate's educational background and their career plans.

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B.) Application requirements

Complete applications must be submitted to PSSFP Registrar's Office in Yaoundé-Messa (Door 231) by 3.30 pm on September 18th, 2026 latest. All applicants must include the following documents :

- 1 registration form, to be downloaded from <http://www.pfinancespubliques.org>;
- 1 certified true copy of the required degree or certificate of successful completion (bachelor's degree), duly signed by the university authorities and issued within the last three months;
- 1 certified photocopy of the birth certificate, issued within the last three months;
- Transcripts of marks for the bachelor's degree program (L1, L2, L3), duly signed by the university authorities;
- A detailed CV ;
- A motivation letter;
- Proof of current employment or authorisation from the employer is required (where applicable);
- One A4 envelope, stamped at the standard rate and bearing the candidate's address;
- A receipt for payment to the « **Crédit Mutuel d'Investissement du Cameroun** », of **fifty thousand (50,000) CFA francs** as an application fee, or a postal order addressed to the Administrative and Financial Manager of PSSFP, PO Box 2332, Yaoundé-Messa.

C.) Selection

Selection is based on :

1. Review of application documents and an interview before a panel for candidates who have enrolled on the face-to-face course;
2. Review of application documents only for candidates who have enrolled on the distance-learning course.

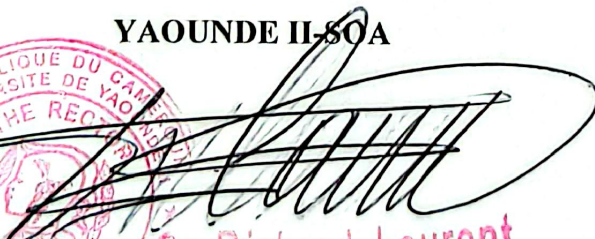
D.) Admission
